<p>padding = PAD/PBG sagging = SAG/PBG jotting = SKWROT/PBG hopping = HOP/PBG → hedging = HEPBLG/PBG mating = PHAEUT/PBG making = PHAEUBG/PBG faking = TPAEUBG/PBG laughing = HRAF/PBG → batting = PWAT/PBG loving = HROV/PBG plumbing = PHRUPL/PBG muggings = PHUG/PBGs stabblings = STAB/PBGs meeting = PHAOET/PBG → meetings = PHAOET/PBGs clippings = KHREUP/PBGs</p>	<p><u>The Come Back Principle:</u> Always come back for the -ing endings except in briefs</p> <p><u>The Throw-In Principle</u> In <u>some</u> words <u>some</u> endings can be “thrown in” to the root word, thus creating a brief form.</p> <p>For the -ing ending throw in the “g”: grading = GRAEUGD; splitting = SPHREUGT; swimming = SWEUPLG</p>	<p>HOPG</p> <p>HRAFG PWAGT HROVG PHRUPLG</p> <p>PHAOEGT PHAOEGTS</p>
